

ESAS aims and objectives are

- to strengthen the European schizophrenia research community
- to deal with specific European issues in schizophrenia research and treatment (e.g. harmonisation of quality assurance measures like treatment guidelines)
- to bring together resources and expertise from a number of research institutes in different countries to tackle scientific questions that are key to the advancement in the field
- to initiate, encourage and promote Europe-wide scientific exchange and scientific study projects on schizophrenia
- to provide current information on schizophrenia

Respective measures are

- to organize meetings like the European Conference on Schizophrenia Research (ECSR), but also seminars, workshops
- to initiate and manage collaborative research on basic, clinical and health services related issues
- to develop and offer training and educational programmes
- to lobby for destigmatization of schizophrenia and for schizophrenia research
- to provide health education and consultation
